




## China Summer Teaching Schedule— 2004



**Welcome aboard!** We at EAFI are delighted that you have chosen to spend some of your time this summer teaching English and providing an American model to the Chinese people. The following schedule will provide detail on where you will be, contact information and what generally you will be doing. As a volunteer, your lodging and meals are provided. Out of pocket costs include your visa, airfare from the US to China, and airfare from Kunming to Shanghai. It is suggested you bring extra money for incidentals such as taxi-fare, gifts, etc. For safety, you will be expected to stay with the group and in group activities at all times, and local guides will be provided for special volunteer activities.
